Local Rules.

1. OUT OF BOUNDS

- a) A ball is out of bounds if lying beyond any boundary fence or hedge. (Note - a ball within a fence or hedge may be declared unplayable - See Rule 28).
- b) The car park, clubhouse premises, over the wall boundary adjacent to the first tee, in the flower border to the rear and north side of the clubhouse, or on the path surrounding the clubhouse.
- c) On or over the grass "cutting" between the 18th hole and the practice ground.

2. LATERAL WATER HAZARDS

- a) All ditches surrounding the course.
- b) When playing the 7th hole - the ditch on the right.
- When playing the 8th hole - the ditches on the left.
 When playing the 9th hole - the ditches on the left.
 When playing the 10th hole - the ditch on the left and pond on the right. When playing the 12th hole - the ditch on the right.
 When playing the 14th hole - the ditch on the right.

3. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

The following shall be treated as immovable obstructions - Rule 24-2 applies.

a) The post and wire fence

l to the right of the 15th hole.

b) All staked trees and wire supports.

c) All sprinkler equipment around tees and greens.

d) The bell support posts on holes 1 and 8.

4. A ball lying on the "wrong" putting green, including all the Winter Greens, must be picked and dropped

- See Rule 25-3.

5. Barbed wire surrounding the course is an integral part of the course - there is no relief.

6. Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions - See Rule 24-1.
